Wrestling with themes of loneliness, connection, and purpose, this hope-punk sci-fi from Hugo Award winner Suzanne Palmer is perfect for fans of Becky Chambers's Monk & Robot duology—featuring a cyborg dog!

Be is an old robot who was there, and doesn't want to think about what happened, or what role they played in that conflict. They have settled into a life of isolation in the abandoned ruins of an old mill in the former New York Botanical Gardens, disinterested in what has happened in the outside world since they stepped away from the war.

When Be is attacked and one of their legs is stolen, Be sets out to find the thief accompanied by a cyborg dog and a human mechanic. The world has changed, but the recovery from the war is uneven and faltering, and Be begins to suspect a malicious force trying to rekindle the old conflict and finish what was started.
